Generalist Pathway

Australian Public Servants encounter risk every day in the course of their work. The Generalist Pathway provides learning and resources to help actively manage risk in the workplace. The Generalist Pathway includes two components; both of which are available through the Comcover Learning Centre.

1. Practical Risk Management

Practical Risk Management: More than just ticking boxes is a blended learning program comprising an eLearning course and a one-day workshop. You can:

1. complete just the eLearning, which is designed to introduce you to or refresh practical steps in risk management, and exit at that point; or
2. continue on and complete the workshop to extend your knowledge and skills through an engaging and hands-on approach to learning. Successfully completing the eLearning assessment is a pre-requisite to attend the workshop.

2. Managing Indemnity Risk

Managing Indemnity Risk is an eLearning course to help you better understand indemnities, and how to reduce likelihood and consequence of the risks that they present. You will learn how risk informed decision making can be applied to practical examples, and what cover is available to Comcover fund member entities.
