

## **Parking Options**

There are several parking options available in the Parkes and Barton area. The map below outlines alternative parking locations in close proximity which can be used following the closure of the York Park Car Park and Windsor Walk in early 2025.

The National Capital Authority (NCA) manages the pay parking arrangements in parts of Parkes, Barton, Russell and Acton on behalf of the Australian Government, including enforcement and breaches of parking regulations.

## John Gorton Campus Car Park

The John Gorton Campus Car Park is anticipated to open in early 2025 and will provide over 1,000 car spaces in a multi-level car park in Parkes, ACT. The car park will also offer:

- 16 EV charging stations
- 11 accessible parking spaces
- 16 motorcycle bays.

The John Gorton Campus Car Park is an enabling project for the development of the National Security Office Precinct (the Precinct) which will be located at the York Park Car Park, Barton ACT. The development of the Precinct will result in the closure of the York Park Car Park in early 2025. The John Gorton Campus Car Park will replace the loss of car parking spaces from York Park.
