

Further background information about the 7CPA is included below:

Seventh Community Pharmacy Agreement (7CPA)

The 7CPA is an agreement made between the Minister for Health and Aged Care, the Pharmacy Guild of Australia and the Pharmaceutical Society of Australia. The 7CPA ends on 30 June 2025 and sets out how pharmacists are reimbursed for:

- dispensing Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) medicines; and
- administering Community Pharmacy Programs.

The Pharmacy Guild has indicated its willingness to enter into an Eighth CPA.

Dispensing PBS medicines

Dispensing fees and mark-ups for wholesalers and pharmacists account for the majority of remuneration to pharmacists under the 7CPA. The savings generated by the 2023-24 Budget measure, changing the maximum dispensed quantity for PBS medicines, are highly dependent on the current fee and mark-up structure.

Community Pharmacy Programs

The 7CPA includes an agreement to provide \$1.2 billion over five years from 2020-21 in funding for Community Pharmacy Programs. \$47C

In the 2023-24 Budget, the Government provided funding to meet projected overspends, noting the uptake of the Community Pharmacy Programs has been greater than anticipated, with the 7CPA funding package of \$1.2 billion for Community

Pharmacy Programs likely to be exhausted by July 2024.

Data on the use of Community Pharmacy Programs is published on the Department of Health website at: Pharmacy Programs data | Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care and confirms an increase in demand.

Pharmacy location rules

The 7CPA continued the Location Rules, which restrict who can own a pharmacy and where these pharmacies can be located. The <u>Interim Report</u> on the effect of red tape on pharmacy rules found that red tape continues to unnecessarily and adversely affect the efficient operation of community pharmacies, to the ultimate detriment of consumers and contrary to the National Medicines Policy.

Whilst no one in the team was around for the drafting of this measure text, we can provide our interpretation.

The figure in the measure text below (\$18.3 billion) demonstrates the total quantum of the 7CPA. This includes previous decisions (including funding within the Contingency Reserve that was made public by merging into the Health line), fees and mark-ups to pharmacies and wholesalers, community pharmacy programs and also patient contributions.

It's likely the table only includes funding released from the Contingency Reserve and some new expenditure such as increased fees and mark-up expenditure over and above what would have occurred if the 6CPA continued.

In terms of the funding being referred to as new *and existing*, our interpretation is *existing funding* refers to the PBS Special Appropriation which would have continued on the basis of the 6CPA, if the 7CPA was not agreed.

The quantum of *existing funding* in the PBS Special Appropriation which would continue under the 7CPA if the 8CPA is not agreed by 1 July 2025 is not yet known. This is the modelling Health is working on at the moment.


